Why our Du'as are not accepted?

Ḥadhrat Ibrāhīm Ibn Adham (Raḥimahullah) a third century scholar and a companion of Ḥadhrat Sufyān al-Thawrī (Raḥimahullah), was asked about the verse, "And your Rabb says: 'call on me I will answer your supplications..." [Surah Ghāfir - 60] but we supplicate and but we are not answered."

So he said to them:

- 1. You know Allāh, yet you do not obey Him,
- 2. You recite the Qurān, yet do not act according to it,
- 3. You know Shaytān, yet you have agreed with him,
- 4. You proclaim that you love Nabi + yet you abandon his Sunnah,
- 5. You proclaim your yearn for Paradise, yet you do not act to gain it,
- 6. You proclaim your fear for the Fire, yet you do not prevent yourselves from sins,
- 7. You say "Indeed death is true", yet you have not prepared for it,
- 8. You engage yourselves with finding faults with others, yet you do not look at your own faults,
- 9. You eat of that which Allah has provided for you, yet you are not grateful to Him
- 10. You bury your dead, yet you do not take a lesson from it."
